During the event he gave away a few brief, but interesting details about a pivotal scene in *The Dark Knight Rises*. "There's an emotional scene coming up in the next *Batman*, which I am obviously, absolutely sworn to secrecy about... They would kill me. Well, I'd do the press junket and then they'd kill me." "Watching Michael Caine work, as Alfred, was a great lesson for me. Just focus, concentration. He has this emotional scene. I'm kidding you not. It was tears and the whole thing. And it's 'Take 1.' (Oldman snaps his fingers) He got it. 'Take 2' (snaps his fingers again), Got it. Take 3 (snaps his fingers) Got it. He's just on the money. Every single time.
