The episodes are very funny. We get jokey dialogue, slapstick and humorous visual effects, and, for the most part, they really work. The story moves at a good pace, allowing familiar characters to establish newly refined personalities without imposing on the action. The TMNT, in particular, are full, individual characters right away, which is something previous adaptations have struggled with. The new Michelangelo warrants special mention as the obvious highlight. This Mikey is silly, energetic and always enthused; he's a proper cartoon character.
