

After wrapping up the Ghost Rider story arc last night, Agents of S.H.I.E.L.D. teased a brand new direction in its final moments, with AIDA revealed to have created a Life Model Decoy of Agent Melinda May, which has been planted within the S.H.I.E.L.D. team. The length of time the duplicate has been with the team is currently unknown, and executive producer Jed Whedon has hinted it might be longer than we think due to the copy's ability to mimic human behavior. "We said it at the beginning of the season that [LMDs] were mimicking human behavior. But AIDA took some sort of leap and built a brain of her own and so the real difference is that they represent people that we know and it's not a big robot baddie, and there is some of that obviously, but right now we know that there's one among us who is someone we know," Whedon explained to IGN.
