

The Alien films are at their best when it features a strong female protagonist overcoming the grotesque, chest-bursting galactic parasites and that's apparently where director Ridley Scott is returning with the introduction of Katherine Waterston's Daniels in his Prometheus-sequel/Alien-prequel. Waterston states, "You don't really know what you're made of until you're tested," in describing her character's arc in the film.
