

Speaking with The Playlist, producer Andrew Kosove updated the status on Ridley Scott's upcoming Blade Runner sequel, which is currently unknown as to whether or not it'll be a sequel/prequel. Despite Scott's comments last month saying that the film will be a sequel and likely won't feature Deckard (played by Harrison Ford in the 1982 original), Kosove says that whether or not it will be a sequel will be revealed within the next couple months, as well as confirming that the screenwriter will be announced around the same time. Kosove is also asked about whether or not the film will be Scott's next project after Prometheus, saying that the film is a high priority for him and the project is going forward 'aggressively' in development.
