Even though Dustin Hoffman was Warner Bros. first choice, actor Danny Devito (Taxi) would end up playing the villainous role. Surprisingly the makeup only took two hours a day to apply, but the transformation was so powerful that Devito actually stayed in character during takes. He even wore The Penguin makeup while doing voice-over sessions for the film, because without it he struggled to find the character's voice. The look of Tim Burton's Penguin was a huge departure from the comic book and television versions, which for the most part only included a pointy nose.
