

According to Box Office Guru (via Twitter), Steven Spielberg & Peter Jackson's The Adventures of Tintin opened big in Europe, with \$55.8 million from 19 markets. It was previously reported that film had a strong opening day in France, where it grossed \$4.7 million, making more than the first Spider-Man film, all Lord of the Ring movies, as well as Pirates of the Caribbean movies. Over the weekend, it made \$21.5 million in France, \$10.7 million in UK, \$2.1 million in Belgium, \$6.7M in Spain , \$4.6M in Germany , \$1.8M in Switzerland , \$1.6 million in Denmark , \$1.3M in Holland , \$1.3M in Italy. The Adventures of Tintin was #1 in 17 out of 19 markets.
