

Deadline reports that Doctor Strange looks set to earn between \$40 million - \$42 million at the North American box office this weekend. That's a drop of only 52% and will ensure that the critically acclaimed Marvel Studios movie remains at #1. That's despite stiff competition from Trolls and new release Arrival, a movie with some serious star power thanks to leads Jeremy Renner and Amy Adams. Doctor Strange has now passed \$100 million domestically in just six days, but don't expect the Scott Derrickson helmed release to end up reaching \$1 billion worldwide. The trade adds that despite it performing better than expected overseas, that's a figure it's unlikely to reach, especially with Fantastic Beasts and Where to Find Them right around the corner (that's pretty much a guaranteed hit). However, it's thought that Doctor Strange will end up finishing its run with \$750 million - \$850 million. That's an incredible result, and one which guarantees a sequel as it's well beyond
