

More good news for Marvel's The Avengers! Joss Whedon's superhero ensemble is now closing in on \$600 million domestically (it dropped just 21% this weekend, making \$7 million and taking its total to \$598.3 million). Overseas, it has now made an incredible \$837.9 million, meaning that Earth's Mightiest Heroes currently hold the #3 spot on the all-time highest grossing movies list with \$1.436 billion worldwide.
