

Here's a box office update for Sony Pictures' Men In Black 3, which has been playing in theaters since May 25th. According to The Hollywood Reporter, the third flick in the successful film series has now grossed \$599.4 million worldwide, which is the highest gross in the Barry Sonnenfeld-directed series. The original Men In Black earned \$589.4M Men In Black II (2002) grossed a lower \$441.8M globally. Men In Black 3's international gross was \$429.8M, compared to \$169.6M domestically (ironically, this is the lowest domestic gross of the series). The threequel (which stars Will Smith, Tommy Lee Jones and Josh Brolin) has earned big numbers in Japan, grossing \$37.6M so far. The movie has grossed \$32.8M in the UK, while receiving \$24.2M in Germany. This should be good news for Sony, as there has been discussions of a possible fourth film in the series.
