

Marvel's The Avengers is still doing great both domestically and overseas, but The Hollywood Reporter reveals that Men in Black 3 will be the film that finally takes back the #1 spot after a solid few weeks for Joss Whedon's superhero ensemble at the top. The threequel (which had a whopping \$230 million budget) looks set to dominate the Memorial Day holiday with an expected four-day gross of between \$80 million and \$90 million. Some analysts are even predicting \$100 million. It's thought that it will also have no trouble taking around \$200 million internationally. The Avengers has so far grossed \$472.2 million domestically and \$747.4 million internationally, steadily moving up the list of all-time highest grossing movies.
