

The latest box office figures are in, and it looks like they've been having a very merry Christmas in the galaxy far, far away. Gareth Edwards' Rogue One: A Star Wars Story continues to dominate, and is expected to close out its second weekend with nearly \$140 million over the six-day holiday, taking in over \$80 million over Christmas Sunday and Stephen's Day alone.
