

According to The Hollywood Reporter, Rogue One: A Star Wars Story kicked off its run at the domestic box office with a massive \$29 million from Thursday night previews. That's pretty much exactly what analysts predicted, and the movie earned more than both Batman v Superman: Dawn of Justice (\$27.7 million) and Captain America: Civil War (\$25 million). That means it scored the biggest debut of 2016, though it's a figure which doesn't quite match Star Wars: The Force Awakens' massive \$57 million. As of right now, it's thought that Rogue One will have an opening weekend of \$135 million - \$150 million. Overseas, it's been in some theaters since Wednesday, and tracking points to a global bow of \$300 - \$350 million worldwide. It had already earned \$33 million by Thursday, so this is a great start! Rogue One doesn't face too much competition this weekend as Collateral Beauty (which stars Will Smith) is the only other major new opening. However, that's been
