

Deadline reports that Len Wiseman's Total Recall remake looks set to give The Dark Knight Rises a run for its money at the North America box office this weekend as matinee trends indicate that the weekend will pan out far differently than previously reported (read details on that by clicking [HERE](#)). Total Recall is on course to gross between \$9.5 million - \$12.5 million today and \$26 million - \$32 million for the weekend (that's an awful lot higher than the prediction which had it on course for a paltry \$20 million opening for third place behind Diary Of A Wimpy Kid 3: Dog Days). Meanwhile, Christopher Nolan's epic finale to his Batman trilogy is predicted to have a weekend total of \$27 million - \$33 million. A slightly better estimate, but a VERY close contest between the two films.

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
