

The tragic shooting at a midnight screening of The Dark Knight Rises last week almost certainly had an impact on its opening weekend (\$160.9 million), but the third and final film in Christopher Nolan's trilogy has now passed \$200 million domestically. This makes it the seventh film of 2012 to hit the landmark figure, and while it didn't get there quite as quickly as the other big superhero movie of the year - Marvel's The Avengers - it still did so in only six days. It earned £13.8 million yesterday, taking its current domestic total to \$211.8 million. It is thought that it will hit \$280 million by the end of next weekend and is performing much, much better than most third instalments do when compared to their predecessors.
