

The Dark Knight Rises only pulled in \$18M domestically on Friday, but deadline is reporting that Saturday's take was forty-two percent higher with \$25.6M. So instead of yesterday's prediction of a 78% drop from the opening weekend it's now projected to be a more reasonable drop of 59%. Domestically the film has pulled in a hefty \$290M through Sunday, making it the 3rd highest number for a movie's first 10 days in release. Second highest is The Dark Knight which during that same stretch totaled \$313.7M, and Marvel's The Avengers is the champ with an astounding \$373M. The Dark Knight Rises will now become the third fastest to reach \$300M. Globally The Dark Knight Rises is nearing a half a billion in its first 10 days. Fantastic numbers, but still not on pace with Nolan's previous Batman film. Most of this is due to the shooting incident in Aurora, Colorado as

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
