

Deadline reports that The Hunger Games has grossed \$131.6 million internationally and \$269.3 million domestically during its first 13 days of release. This of course means that it has now crossed a total of \$400 million at the worldwide box office. Apparently, the big screen adaptation of the Suzanne Collins novel is set to be #1 again for this Easter weekend with an estimated \$12M - \$14M Friday and \$40M over the weekend. Despite this being its third weekend on release, locations are still selling out and it has held off competition from other big releases such as American Reunion and Titanic 3D.
