

As expected, Transformers: Dark of the Moon did well on Friday, taking in \$33.5 million, after making over \$64 million since opening on Tuesday. With a total of over \$100 million expected throughout the weekend, and \$185 million predicted after the 4th of July, this is yet another huge success in the franchise, despite being a slight drop on what Transformers: Revenge of the Fallen made back in 2009. As Deadline report, "Projections are for foreign to close in on \$200M through Monday for a \$385 global cume in its first 7 days since sequels do better overseas than they do domestic."
