

"There's great opportunity for that," producer Stephen Broussard told Daily News about possibly revisiting the fairgrounds in Flushing Meadows-Corona Park in Queens. "Absolutely, there's more to explore there. It's a real place. That always helps people connect to these characters." He apparently refused to reveal which movie will see Captain America return to his old stomping grounds, but went on to further discuss why Flushing Meadows (which also appeared in Iron Man 2) is the perfect location to ground a character like Steve Rogers in the real world.
