

According to Comic Book Resources, DC will launch a digital comic book series based on new CW show Arrow this October. Priced at \$0.99 an issue, it will debut on October 10th - the same day as the series premiere - and will be written by executive producers, showrunners and comic scribes Marc Guggenheim and Andrew Kreisberg with art from legendary artist Mike Grell and later Sergio Sandoval and Jorge Jimenez. The series will sell at \$0.99 a chapter online, while monthly print editions collecting several installments will start on November 28th for \$3.99. "We've been working like mad," Guggenheim told the site about balancing work on the TV series and comic book. "It was a little while after the free comic we co-wrote with Geoff Johns for San Diego Comic-Con [when DC approached us].
