

A CGC 9.4 grade copy of Journey Into Mystery #83 has raised \$222,200 at a sale by Pedigree Comics earlier this week. As you may already know, Thor was introduced in this 1962 comic book in a story entitled "The Stone Men From Saturn", and was created by Stan Lee, Larry Lieber, Jack Kirby and Joe Sinnott. The book was eventually retitled THOR in 1966 as the popularity of the character increased. You might want to check your attic's as two other CGC 9.4 copies are known to be in circulation as is a CGC 9.6 issue.
