

Denis Leary, the actor portraying "George Stacy", father Emma Stone's "Gwen Stacy" in Marc Webb's much-anticipated film The Amazing Spider-Man, recently chatted with MTV. And tight-lipped on speculation of his character's fate in the reboot, when questioned of it, his answer may hint at the film's ending. "I'm not allowed to say anything about the ending of 'Spider-Man' — or the ending of 'Rescue Me,' " he told us at the opening festivities for the Tribeca Film festival. "It's verboten! I can't tell you!" Leary himself didn't dive back into the "Spider-Man" vaults for research purposes, reading up on his character's history. Instead he relied on the knowledge of both helmer Marc Webb and the webslinger's creator.
