

Showblitz reports that after sitting out last year's San Diego Comic-Con, both Marvel and Warner Bros. are bringing the big guns to the event this July. A first look at footage from Iron Man 3 is "firmly expected" according to the site, while a three hour block has been reserved by Warner Bros. on the Saturday for a presentation which is expected to include The Hobbit: An Unexpected Journey and the debut of footage from Zack Snyder's Man of Steel.
