

One half of Han Solo directing duo, Chris Miller, has officially announced that shooting has begun on the upcoming Star Wars anthology flick. Miller posted an image of a film slate with the words "Star Wars: Red Cop", which we're pretty certain isn't going to be the actual title of the movie. He's also captioned it with a clever little play on the oft-repeated mantra of Star Wars geeks the world over: "Han shot first".
