

With *Beauty and the Beast* on track to be a huge box office hit, it's no surprise that Disney is continuing at full speed with adaptations of their animated classics. The studio's remake of *Mulan* is next on the list, and Niki Caro has now been confirmed to helm the movie. According to *The Hollywood Reporter*, the studio made an effort to find an Asian director (consulting *Ang Lee* and *Rogue One: A Star Wars Story* star *Jiang Wen*, who both had to pass) before settling on Caro. Disney also considered *Wonder Woman* director *Patty Jenkins*, and *Michelle MacLaren* (*Breaking Bad*, *The Walking Dead*, *Game of Thrones*.) Caro being hired to direct the film will most likely nix her chances of directing *Marvel Studios' Captain Marvel* film, for which she was reportedly in the running. In addition to Caro, the studio has also hired Hong-Kong based producer *Bill Kong* to oversee the film. Kong is famous for producing films such as *House of Flying*
