

The international box office numbers for this weekend are here...As you all know, Green Lantern didn't make enough money in US as many thought it will. It's now on \$115 million, and it won't go much higher than that. But, can the international numbers help its gross? "Debuts in six markets including a No. 2 bow in France (\$3.5 million from 480 locations) lifted the overall weekend tally for Marvel Studios' Captain American: The First Avenger to \$12 million from 4,718 venues in 51 territories, and elevated the 3D superhero comic book adaptation's overseas cume to \$147 million.
