

Moving the production from England to Iceland recently, filming for Thor: The Dark World picked up today in the Nordic island country. And Twitter has revealed the presence of actors Chris Hemsworth, Tom Hiddleston, Christopher Eccleston, Adewale Akinnuoye-Agbaje and Zachary Levi. However, the shoot's inclusion of Lady Sif actress Jaimie Alexander isn't expected, even though the Marvel sequel's script may have entailed it; initially. Alexander, 28, revealed on Twitter last month that she sustained quite an injury while on The Dark World set, escaping almost becoming paralyzed. And now, despite the actress periodically tweeting her speedy recovery, the injury has possibly caused Lady Sif to be written out of scenes that're currently being filmed in Iceland.
