

The Sydney Morning Herald was covering Julia Gillard's visit to the set of The Wolverine. Star Hugh Jackman was asked about the tragic events that took place at the screening of The Dark Knight Rises in Aurora, Colorado. "All I can echo is just the sorrow I feel for the families, for the community, for everybody," he said from the set of The Wolverine. "It's an issue that goes obviously way beyond acting, beyond film, beyond anything like that.
