

James Mangold's Logan premiered to rave reviews yesterday at the Berlin International Film Festival, masterfully closing the door on Hugh Jackman's legendary run as Wolverine, but with rumors about a potential team-up swirling, it's hard not to wonder: is this really the end? "When I had the script, I was like, 'Yes... And when I was shooting the movie, yes. As I sit here today, yes.'" Jackman told the New York Times, in a recent profile, before continuing: "God knows how I'll feel in three years, But right now, absolutely." Well, it doesn't get more definitive than that. Jackman has more or less become synonymous with Wolverine over the course of the career, but now that he's closed that chapter of his life, where does he go from here - as an actor? "Let's be clear — I'm not retiring." he said, before elaborating on how he typically feels after completing a film, any film, not just films from the blockbuster X-Men franchise and how Logan
