

The cast of Warner Bros. and director James Wan's Aquaman film continues to fill out its roster. After securing Amber Heard as Mera, Willem Dafoe as Vulko and Patrick Wilson as Ocean Master, the film was recently revealed to have acquired the talents of Nicole Kidman to play Aquaman's mother Atlana, the Queen of Atlantis. In addition, Yahya Abdul-Mateen II was just cast as Black Manta. Of course, the film is headed up by Jason Momoa's physically intimidating rendition of Arthur Curry aka Aquaman.
