

In a lengthy interview with Get Hampshire on his role in Mission Impossible: Ghost Protocol, Jeremy Renner was asked how that differs to working on The Bourne Legacy. "They're very, very different pieces of cinema, both meant to entertain," he said. "Mission's a bit more fun, more smiles in it, it's a popcorn movie. They're obviously both spy movies but very different, Bourne's never been on a mission, you know what I mean? You never see him do spy-work at all. He's always running for his life and that's kind of what that thing is in a sense."
