

MTV Splash Page recently caught up with the mastermind behind Marvel's ever-expanding shared cinematic universe, Kevin Feige, to discuss the future of Marvel's The Avengers big mid-credits surprise. Revealing that plans have been set in stone for Thanos, Feige keeps mum on reports that the Mad Titan will next appear in Guardians of the Galaxy. Also commenting on casting for the plum villain, Feige explains: "There's a great track record now about lobbying something in at the last moment to get the audience buzzing. Particularly when it came to Thanos, [we knew] that most people in that audience had no idea who that purple guy was — but they could clearly tell he was important, and knew if they asked the two or three people sitting next to them, somebody would know who he was."
