

The build up to Avengers: Infinity War has begun, with Doctor Strange, Guardians of the Galaxy Vol.2, Spider-Man: Homecoming, Thor: Ragnarok, and Black Panther all set to be released in the wake of Captain America: Civil War and before Thanos arrives on Earth. In a new interview with IGN, Kevin Feige sheds some light on how the first of the Russo Brothers' two upcoming Avengers movies differ from each other and what will happen when Earth's Mightiest Heroes finally face the Mad Titan. "There's a reason we have publicly called the first one 'Infinity War' and the second one 'Untitled,' because the movies we were developing were not -- certainly there's a connection, there are with all our movies -- but it's not a first part and a second part," the Marvel boss explained to the site. "It's a whole movie and a whole story, and then a whole movie and a whole story. That's about all I can say. It's certainly inspired by everything that has come before and everything that is hinted at before." Those comments
