

In addition to their awesome Black Manta scoop from earlier today, The Hollywood Reporter has learned that Nicole Kidman is also being eyed to join the cast of Warner Bros.' upcoming underwater superhero adventure Aquaman. The Academy Award-winning actress is currently only in early talks for the James Wan-directed film, but if she signs on, she'll portray Aquaman's mother. While the report doesn't give us a name, it's more likely than not she'd be playing his birth mother Atlanna. This is now WB's second attempt at trying to lure Kidman into the DC Films Universe as she was previously in talks with the studio, just a little over a year ago, to join Patty Jenkins' Wonder Woman as Queen Hippolyta, but bowed out fairly early in the process due to a reported scheduling conflict. Also, if her deal closes, this will mark Kidman's second venture into the world of DC superhero movies, having previously portrayed Dr. Chase Meridian in 1995's Batman Forever.
