

The Power Rangers film has been rated PG-13. The rating was confirmed during the recent CES expo in Las Vegas [via Power Rangers Now]. Those still grasping at straws for an R-rated adaptation will just have to rewatch, the dark Power/Rangers short film from Adi Shankar's Bootleg Universe. According to Variety, Lionsgate Motion Picture Group President Erik Feig was "particularly optimistic about "Power Rangers," which opens on March 24, noting that the first trailer generated more than 150 million views in its first 48 hours."
