

Speaking with GQ about his latest movie *We Bought A Zoo*, Damon mentions why he wouldn't return to any further Bourne movies: "If you look at the first three movies, we kind of pounded that idea of identity and amnesia into the ground. We really got everything out of it that we could. So to reboot it, we need to come up with something completely new." He also touched on Tony Gilroy's failed Bourne Ultimatum script which was heavily rewritten: "I don't blame Tony for taking a boatload of money and handing in what he handed in. It's just that it was unreadable. This is a career-ender. I mean, I could put this thing up on eBay and it would be game over for that dude. It's terrible. It's really embarrassing. He was having a go, basically, and he took his money and left." Damon admits that Jeremy Renner's casting was "A surprise." But
