

A lot of criticism for George Lucas's Star Wars prequels fell on their over-reliance for CGI characters and environments as opposed to the practical visual effects the series was built on. Thankfully when the franchise was purchased by Disney in 2012, Lucasfilm president Kathleen Kennedy promised the priority of using practical VFX over CGI (when possible) during the making of the new films. The Force Awakens lived up to fan expectations by having a very intricate balance between CGI and practical effects, and based on a new featurette, it looks like Rogue One: A Star Wars Story will be following suit. The short clip provides a look at some of the film's new creatures and the process that goes into crafting their realistic facial expressions and movements.
