

Filming of The Avengers also took place at Creekside Mushroom Farms (Worthington, Pennsylvania) for a chase sequence which involved Loki, Agent Coulson and Maria Hill. The site has over 150 miles of abandoned limestone tunnels and encompasses 800 acres beneath the surface. It took months to prepare the location, although actor Tom Hiddleston explains why it all paid off in the end. "It was just extraordinary down there. We were shooting a chase scene with about fifteen SUVs, driving 50 mph up and down the tunnels. I was loosely strapped to the back of the truck, and there's just no substitute for the real experience. It feels exciting, dangerous and dramatic and you can feel the energy and dynamism of the shot. I think the sequence is going to be extraordinary. Personally, I let everyone know on first unit that it was probably one of the coolest locations I have ever

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
