

The pilot for The Munsters remake will be broadcast on Friday, Oct. 26, rebranded as a Halloween special. At the end of the show you will learn why Grandpa Munster (Eddie Izzard) goes from looking like an elderly man, to some several decades younger. You can see his younger version in the first image below with the rest of the cast. Also have a new image of Herman Munster (Jerry O'Connell) sporting a mechanical heart, and concept art of the family's pet, named Spot. The pilot, written by Bryan Fuller and to be directed by Bryan Singer, is described as a reinvention of the 1960s sitcom about The Munsters, a family of "monsters" — vampires, werewolves and Frankenstein, and their "plain" cousin (Charity Wakefield) — that will feature striking visuals in the vein of Fuller's ABC dramedy Pushing Daisies.
