

In an interview with timeout.com Craig talks about the problems that plagued his last Bond movie. He also gushes about the new Bond film, and talks about which past Bond movies inspired him and Sam Mendes. On Quantum of Solace: Turning his mind to Bond, Craig admits that 'Quantum of Solace' (2008) was a frustrating experience, not least because the Hollywood writers' strike meant they ended up filming with an incomplete script. 'We were fucked,' he says. 'We had the bare bones of a script and then there was the strike and there was nothing we could do. We couldn't employ a writer to finish it. There was me trying to rewrite scenes – and a writer I am not. We were stuffed.'
