

While we continue to wait with bated breath for our first look at Marvel and Sony's Spider-Man: Homecoming tonight, some new details on the film have arrived via USA Today. While action and excitement will no doubt compose a large part of the film, star Tom Holland sees Homecoming as less of an action film and "more a character piece about this kid who's struggling to talk to girls and also struggling to save the city." As evidenced in previous interviews, the film will kick off with Peter Parker returning to his normal life in Queens after his major battle in this summer's Captain America: Civil War, a secret the young Peter will struggle with.
