

After success with the Black Dynamite live-action movie, co-written & starring Michael Jai-White (Spawn, Mortal Kombat: Legacy), as well the Black Dynamite: Slave Island graphic novel, the Black Dynamite story continues with the new animated series from Adult Swim. The site has posted the first episode of the series that is planned for a spring 2012 premiere. Does it live up to the movie? And will there be an audience to make it last? This writer might like it more than the movie—where the movie dragged on at times. The 15-minute pilot and a planned 30-minute run time on the series provides a tighter more enjoyable watch. The show teams Boondocks writer and producer Carl Jones with the cast and creators of the Black Dynamite film. Clearly from the pilot the show has the same look and art style as Boondocks which fits nicely with the 70s old school cartoon aesthetic.
