The character will be introduced as an attendant to Kurt Russell's Ego the Living Planet when she meets the team - in fact, she's spent her whole life with him. "So, she's an alien. And she's always with — at the beginning, she's spent her life with Kurt Russell's character," Klementieff told Mashable. "She was pretty lonely and then she meets the Guardians and...that's it.
