

Power Rangers fans continue to wait with very thin patience for a second trailer for the upcoming franchise reboot, though Saban seems content with toys, set photos and a few official pictures doing most of the talking for their film. The brand's latest marketing push comes in the form of a virtual reality tie-in game, Power Rangers: Zords Rising. We got a very blurry shot of the game two days ago, along with our first look at Bryan Cranston's Zordon. Now, a brand new poster advertising the game has given us another look at the Rangers and the robotic Alpha 5 (Bill Hader), along with what appears to be the film's version of the Rangers' command centre and the portal through which Zordon will appear.
