

Ruth Negga has been a TV star in her adopted homeland of Ireland (she was actually born in Ethiopia) for a few years now, but she only recently got her break in the US with roles in the likes of Agents of S.H.I.E.L.D. and Preacher. Now, as she seems poised to take Hollywood by storm with a critically acclaimed turn in Jeff Nichols' Loving, the actress speaks to Vogue about her career in a new interview which you can check out here.
