The Red Hulk though is about to be put out to pasture, as Greg Pak's run ends with the August addition. But don't you worry, the big jolly green giant is coming back in October. After Marvel's "Fear Itself" panel concluded Sunday, Newsarama was able to get details from writer/Marvel Architect Jason Aaron (Wolverine, Scalped). When the story picks-up you'll see a literal split of Banner and the Hulk. The characters will be physically split, which is something we haven't seen since the John Byrne run. What follows is an excerpt from the article Nrama: It sounds like that conflict between Bruce Banner and the Hulk is very literal in your series — they're separate — and you'll be looking at Bruce Banner as the real threat, not the Hulk?
