

The first trailer for Spider-Man: Homecoming will run for only 1:41, a standard length for most teasers, but a running time which disappointed those of us hoping for a lengthier first look at the reboot. However, things just took a pretty amazing turn as Marvel Studios President Kevin Feige has told USA Today that two different version will debut tonight containing different footage and lines of dialogue. "The first trailers will be unveiled online Thursday night — one domestic (premiering on ABC's Jimmy Kimmel Live!) and one international," the site reports, "with a few different shots and lines of dialogue between them. 'Enough where I thought it would be fun for people to see both,' producer and Marvel Studios president Kevin Feige." That's a pretty interesting strategy, but a good way to ensure that comic book fans check out both and have plenty to talk about over the next few weeks.
