

“She (Anne Hathaway) did a wonderful job. She really trained so hard for it. She managed to find a place for herself where she could make this version of Catwoman work within Chris Nolan’s world of Batman,” he told Access. “I remember when she first read for it, I turned to Chris and I said, ‘I think that’s what you’re looking,’... I could see that through the costume a Catwoman.
