

The Avengers earned another \$20,610,225 from Blu-ray and \$12,685,810 from DVD sales in its second week of release bringing its home video earnings to a total of \$136,401,028 USD [\$48,097,975 DVD + \$88,303,053 Blu-ray]. Batman: The Dark Knight Returns Part 1 also in its second week of release earned another \$556,657 from Blu-ray and \$354,685 from DVD. The animated direct-to-video feature film has accumulated a combined \$3,062,256 USD thus far. [\$2,056,794 Blu-ray + \$1,005,462 DVD].
