

When Christopher Nolan agreed to helm 2008's *The Dark Knight*, part of the deal with Warner Bros. was that they allowed him to shoot the film in IMAX (there was ultimately 40 minutes of such footage in the completed film). However, reveal that *The Dark Knight Rises* will contain the most IMAX footage EVER - more than an hour's worth. IMAX apparently have yet to commit to any IMAX films this August and September as they're planning on giving the third and final instalment of Christopher Nolan's Batman franchise as much time on their screens as possible. The film will be screened at 100 locations across the US. "I felt if we could have one of those in every major city, we could justify the difficulty of going to a lot of trouble to shoot this way. You will see a crisper image," said the director. "There was a huge
